

Care & Use Card

Simple handling notes for printed cookie cutters and stamps. Keep this card with your digital download or include it as a bonus file for buyers.

Best everyday habits

Treat printed cutters gently, keep them clean, and avoid unnecessary heat. Small care habits help preserve edges and shape.

Before use

- Inspect the print before use and make sure the shape looks complete and stable.
- Rinse and hand wash before first use.
- Lightly flour the dough and the cutter if your dough tends to stick.

During use

- Press straight down for the cleanest outline.
- If the dough is very soft, chill it briefly before cutting.
- Avoid twisting delicate shapes more than necessary.

Cleaning

- Hand wash only with mild soap and lukewarm water.
- Do not place common printed cutters in high heat or dishwasher cycles unless you already know the material can handle it.
- Dry fully before storing.

Storage

- Store flat when possible to help protect the shape.
- Keep away from direct sun, heaters, hot cars, and other high-heat environments.
- Do not stack heavy items on top of thin or detailed shapes.
